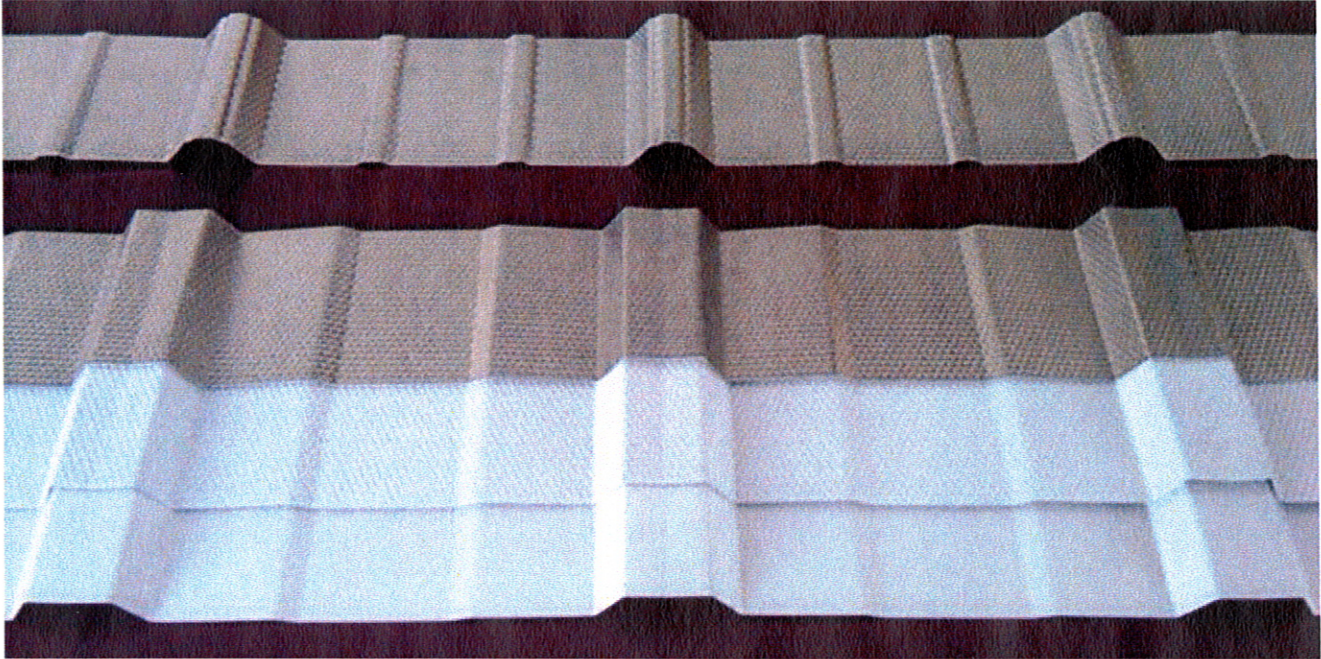

Liner Panels are the interior walls of a metal building. They consist of either K-Rib profile in 3 foot wide panel coverage. They are screwed to the framing. Liner panels can be used for full or partial height liners. They protect the insulation of the building and the exterior walls, while enhancing the interior of the building by giving it a more finished pre-engineered look. Designed for metal buildings, liner panels will out-perform plywood or drywall, while being considerably more cost effective.

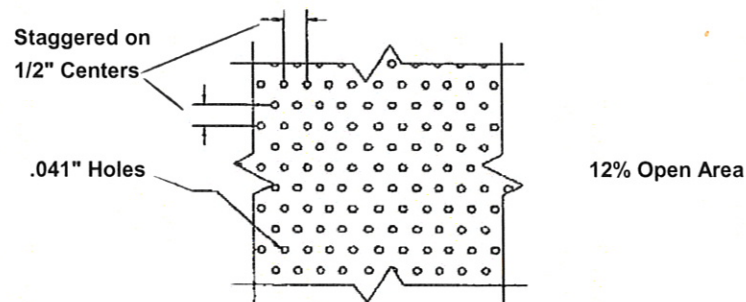

K-Rib Perforated Interior Liner Panels

K-Rib *Suburban*



- * Available in (.015) thickness Painted Galvanized Steel.
- * Both the Frontier or Suburban profiles available.
- * 3 Ft. Wide Coverage.
- * Entire panel is perforated, using IPA number 111 protocol.
- * Hole size is .041 diameter, on 1/2" staggered centers, with minimum margins parallel to length. Straight rows of holes will be parallel to the panel width. 19 holes per sq. inch, resulting in 12% open area.
- * Standard Polyester Two-Coat Paint System.
- * 5 Year Paint Warranty
- * Stock or custom lengths available.
- * For internal use only.

Perforated K-Rib Liner Panels provide a more finished look to the interior of a metal building, while providing a significant reduction in the reflective noise level in the building. Acoustical K-Rib Liner Panels protect both the insulation of the building and the exterior walls.
